1	Open Pedagogy & Practice (P)
Actions to be developed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Piloting the “Open Education: fundamentals and approaches” course inside the university. - Disseminate the “Open Education: fundamentals and approaches” course between other Palestinian universities. - Conduct workshops for Faculty members, students at our university and other Palestinian universities.
Description	<p>Piloting the “Open Education: fundamentals and approaches” course inside our university to raise the awareness about OER and OEP to provide them with the main concepts and best practices. And organize a way to share it with other Palestinian universities in order to disseminate the culture of openness.</p> <p>Provide workshops in parallel with the course piloting to make sure that the process is achieving the course outcomes.</p> <p>Develop small projects from each group as an open resource.</p>

2	Governance & business models (G)
Actions to be developed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Meetings with the decision makers to discuss Open Licences - Participating in developing national policy
Description	Drafting a policy for licensing all OE materials (open courses, research...) by increasing the awareness at management level, professors and students about the importance of OE.
Timeframe	1 year
Priority (if applicable)	High

Expected results and impact	Decision makers aware of the advantages of the OE in enhancing the education process. A policy that covers all of the OE practices at the university level.
People, teams or department in charge	OpenMed project team, turin week participants, elearning center

3	Open Content & Licenses (C)
Actions to be developed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Conduct training workshops about the types of open licenses and how to apply it to the produced materials. - Disseminating all licensed materials on our LMS.
Description	The workshop will be held twice a year to cover all of the university professors to train them about the open licensing.
Timeframe	3 years
Prioroty (if applicable)	High
Expected results and impact	Professotrs aware of how to use and apply open licenses. Redesign their applicable materials to license it. Gradually all material produced will be openly licensed.
